The March 12th meeting will be held in the school cafeteria at **Abiding Savior Lutheran Church at 4355 Butler Hill Road**. This is north of the Schnucks shopping center at Highway 55 and Butler Hill Road. The cafeteria is located on the lower level of the church and is accessible by elevator. Park in the back of the church to enter. We've invited candidates for the Mehlville School Board to speak to the March meeting.



February Meeting Highlights

Three candidates for the Lindbergh School Board spoke. Karen Schuster is running for re-election. She has a background as an auditor, is a graduate of the Lindbergh school system and has four children who are in various levels of the Lindbergh school system. Kate Holloways is running for re-election. She is the mother of five Lindbergh graduates. Dan Sampson has a doctorate in computer science and works for St. Louis County. He is the father of two small children, one is starting pre-school, the other will be.

All three candidates agreed on the need for fiscal responsibility and less federal control of the school district as manifested in Common Core. They also agreed that immigrant children are being well-served in learning English as a second language and assimilating. They are open to school vouchers being used by children from other districts only as long as Lindbergh has control over class sizes and gets properly reimbursed. When asked "What would you like to see done differently?" They offered different answers.

Schuster: (1) Would like more open dialogue with the community and (2) more resources and accountability in extracurricular activities.

Holloway: Would like changes in the content of the history and literature curriculum.

Sampson: (1) Would like more life skills incorporated in the curriculum. (2) Wants to be more pro-active with regard to the growth in the community. This is referring to the population growth and the burden it places on the school system.

The following people were endorsed by the club. Jamie Murphy for election to the Mehlville School Board. Kate Holloway for re-election to the Lindbergh School Board. Tony Pousosa for 6th District St. Louis County Council. Additional candidates may also be endorsed in the March meeting.

Senator Jim Lembke is the 2015 Republican of the Year and will be recognized at the spring fundraiser dinner on Sunday April 26th.

Tony Pousosa introduced himself as candidate for the 6th district, St. Louis County Council. Dan Reuter introduced himself to the club and announced his candidacy for state representative of the 96th District. He is the second member of the club to announce his candidacy for this office. Treasurer David Gregory has also announced his intentions to run for the state rep's office.

In our newsletter you will find a new form the St. Louis County Election Board has developed. It is called "Verification of Moved out of St. Louis County/Deceased Voter". Please save a paper copy and also save it to your computer; then distribute it to your sphere of influence. I'll explain how to use it. When I pay my respects at the funeral parlor I get one of the deceased's remembrance cards. I attach it to the filled out form, sign it and send it in to the Board. The Board will then work toward removing that person from the voting rolls. If you have the name, date-of-birth and date-of-death the Board should be able to find that particular voter and work toward removing him.

We all know folks who have moved out of St. Louis County. Please fill out the form with the information you have about that voter. It helps if you have the address and/or date-of-birth. Sign the form and send it in. You can attach any documentation you might have about his move.

We are all called to work in the effort to clean up the voter rolls. These elections are very close. For example, Stream lost to Stenger by about six-tenths of a percent. None of us want fraudulent votes cast in the names of dead people and people who don't live here. Until we get the Voter ID bill passed the very least we can do is work to clean up the voter rolls. Thank you in advance for your efforts.
